Our online submission site will have detailed instructions for uploading the required materials listed below in a single PDF file for your submission. Please note that high resolution images will not be accepted but may be requested at a later date.

Required submissions materials you may want to begin collecting will include the following:

- A one-page nomination letter by a member of the national AIA Board of Directors, or a component or Knowledge Community that summarizes the contributions made
- A biography of the nominee or organization, not to exceed two pages, including a list of offices, positions, honors, publications, and presentations that relate to the purpose of the award
- Exhibits of a maximum of 15 pages with images and/or drawings or other materials to illustrate accomplishments that relate to the purpose of the award
- A minimum of seven to a maximum of ten one-page letters of support that are explicit in their recommendation and contain specific reasons for support
- A portrait of the nominee

Other forms to be completed online will include:

- A nomination sheet
- An intern declaration sheet
- A nominee release form
- A copyright permission form
