Description: Using the proper American National Standard Specifications for ceramic tile, this program will review the proper methodology for researching, evaluating and selecting the appropriate bonding and grouting materials for successful tile installation. Learning Objectives: After completion of this course, participants will be able to:

- List the steps involved in evaluating the proper bonding and grouting material needed for specific tile installation projects.
- Describe what standards must be met for successful tile installation.
- Recognize errors in install projects from photos shown and recommend suggestions for proper install.

Target Audience: Architects, specifiers, interior designers, owners and other design professionals. The ideal audience size can be 10-40 people. This program is basic and meets the needs of professionals at every experience level.

How Taught: The CES facilitator utilizes a PowerPoint or slide presentation to provide an in-depth overview for how to specify the appropriate bonding and grouting materials for tile installation. It will be an interactive session that encourages feedback and questions and a "Fill-in-the-blank" worksheet will be distributed to help reinforce the learning objectives. The program concludes with a review of the installation process and the standards by which this process is measured.
