Submissions

All exhibits must be submitted on a disk in **one single .PDF file** not to exceed **6 MB** for presentation to the Gold Medal/Firm Award Advisory Jury.

- A nomination letter summarizing the nominee's contributions **not to exceed one page** from a member of the national AIA Board of Directors, a representative from an AIA component or AIA Knowledge Community, or from one AIA member sponsoring the nomination by petition.
- A brief biography of the nominee not to exceed two pages
- A statement/list of nominee's achievements/awards not to exceed two pages
- Descriptive statements and photographs of the nominee's work. There should be three images for each project represented, including a site plan and an exterior and interior image whenever possible.
- A maximum of up to 5 letters of support (not to exceed one page each)
- Optional** – miscellaneous material including clippings, articles, etc. not to exceed three pages.

Single .PDF file submitted on disk, but separate file from above-mentioned items:

- A completed Nomination Sheet
- If nomination is made by petition, completed Nomination Petition with signatures, printed names and AIA member numbers of 5 Fellows or 10 AIA members in good standing (none of whom are employed by the nominee's firm)
- Completed Release Forms
- A signed Intern Declaration
- A black and white digital image of the candidate
