


AIA/Deltek Architecture Billings Index (ABI)


The AIA/Deltek Architecture Billings Index (ABI) is a diffusion index derived from the monthly Work-on-the-Boards survey, conducted by the AIA Economics & Market Research Group. The ABI serves as a leading economic indicator that leads nonresidential construction activity by approximately 9-12 months. The survey panel asks participants whether their billings increased, decreased, or stayed the same in the month that just ended. According to the proportion of respondents choosing each option, a score is generated, which represents an index value for each month. An index score of 50 represents no change in firm billings from the previous month, a score above 50 indicates an increase in firm billings from the previous month.


Above 50 Below 50







Regional

Billings remain flat at firms in the Midwest; decline elsewhere.

Graphs represent data from October 2024–October 2025 across the four regions. 50 represents the diffusion center. A score of 50 equals no change from the previous month. Above 50 shows increase; Below 50 shows decrease. 3-month moving average.






Sector

Business conditions remain soft at firms of all specializations.





Architecture firms anticipate declining revenue for 2025 and 2026.

units: % of firms, current estimate for net revenue change for 2025 as compared to 2024, and projected change for 2026 compared to 2025



- Major decline (decrease of 25% or more)
- Significantly down (decrease of 10% to 24%)
- Down somewhat (decrease of 5% to 9%)
- About the same (within 5% of last year)
- Up somewhat (increase of 5% to 9%)
- Up at lot (increase of 10% to 24%)
- Major increase (increase of 25% or more)
