Priorities	Serve in an advisory capacity to AIA on issues related to K-12 architecture education. Inform and alert AIA of pressing issues in K-12 architecture education. Contribute to discussions and presentations that relate to the inspiration and education of K-12 students.
Composition	Past Chair, Chair, Vice Chair, Knowledge & Outreach Committee Leaders, up to twelve (12) geographically represented members, up to one (1) K-12 education, up to one (1) College of Fellows representative, one (1) AIA staff liaison
Term Length	IDEA Group members will serve a two-year calendar year term.
Time Commitment	Monthly full group 1-hour meetings; committee meetings as needed
Appointment Process	Appointment of the at-large members will be made by the Chair with the concurrence of the Vice Chair and Immediate Past Chair.
Quorum	This is an advisory group and not a voting body. When providing recommendations to AIA, the goal is to come to consensus on the group's perspective but can include additional thoughts or factors outside of consensus that may be important to AIA leadership.
Additional information	K-12 IDEA Group was formed in 2017. Past members may continue to serve as emeritus members and attend meetings if they choose.
